## HIGH SCHOOL SUCCESS

Compared to 2018, 1st-quarter Fall 2019 grades racked up 98 A's, with just 1 F and 4 missing assignments. GPA for our 42 high school students was up .36 points to 2.95.

Partial credit goes to the new Learning Center with three study rooms and a spacious classroom. Students made 237 visits in October - 533 for the quarter.



## COMMUNITY SERVICE

89% of 1st - 8th grade students were involved in community activities during the past school year. 83% of 9th - 12th grade students were involved in extracurricular activities or worked a part-time job.

Students participated in 58 community service projects.



## **EQUINE THERAPY**

Four members of the horse nation now reside on campus as part of our therapy program. The horses, with their important place in Native culture, are attuned to the actions and emotions of humans, and are selected for their calm nature and skills to work with children.

Horses are called šuŋkawakȟáŋ by the Lakota, a word conveying a sense of sacred energy.

More than 220 Native American students in 1st - 12th grades find opportunities to grow through our educational, counseling and residential programs. St. Joseph's Indian School transforms lives - mind, body, heart and spirit - every day.
