

# SAFETY MEASURES

To provide the safest possible environment for all students and staff at St. Joseph's Indian School, the following safety measures are in place.

## 01

Testing - all students will be COVID-19 tested on arrival.

## 02

Students will not have any visitors, family or otherwise. They will have opportunities for exercise and fresh air.

## 03

No new students:

- Our focus is on our relationships with current families.
- This allows for an empty home for students recovering from illness.

## 04

Comprehensive cleaning - At minimum, there will be twice-daily cleaning of high-touch surfaces with a trained cleaning team for COVID-19-positive cases.

## 05

Universal masking and temperature taking began for staff July 20 to prepare for the students' safe return.

## 06

Should symptoms arise, as determined by a health care professional, the entire community will be confined to their campus home. That community returns to Phase I. (See separate handout.) Remote learning will be utilized.

## 07

Recovery Home:

- Students who are symptomatic or positive for COVID-19 will be placed in the Recovery Home.
- They will remain there in their rooms per health expert guidelines, probably 10 days at minimum.
- A nurse will call the parent/guardian of the student each day to report on the student's health.
- Distance learning will take place contingent on symptoms and number of students in the home.
