To maximize monitoring and minimize exposures, St. Joseph's Indian School is planning movement for campus, school, lunch, recreation, school restrooms, after-school study, counseling and Mass by home communities. Here's what it looks like.

01

Communities are grades 2 and 3, grades 4, 5 and 6, grades 7 and 8, and high school.

02

Communities will travel to and from school by different routes using separate doors to enter and exit.

03

Counseling will be by community on scheduled days. Equine therapy will be outdoors by community.

Communities will have lunch on staggered schedules. Single-wrap snacks, disposable trays and no self-service are additional safety measures.

05

Grades by community will use specific bathrooms in the school.

06

Grades 5 and 6 will have after-school study in their wing, as will Grades 7 and 8.

07

Recess will take place on a staggered schedule, rotating locations.

08

Mass in Chapel will rotate communities weekly. Others will attend via live-stream.



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
