

SAFETY MEASURES

Updated December 15, 2020

To provide the safest possible environment at St. Joseph's Indian School, the following safety measures are in place.

01

If a student shows symptoms of COVID-19, we will administer a COVID-19 test. We will not require testing for students who do not have symptoms.

02

We strongly request that families refrain from checking students out for the first three weeks (through January 15) to support our efforts to limit any virus spread.

03

There are only a small number of new students, siblings of current students or priority on wait list.

- Our focus is on our relationships with current families.
- This allows for an empty home for students recovering from illness.

04

Comprehensive cleaning - At minimum, there will be twice-daily cleaning of high-touch surfaces with a trained cleaning team for COVID-19-positive cases.

05

For the safety of our students, universal masking and temperature taking began for staff July 20 and continues to the present.

06

Should symptoms arise, as determined by a health care professional, the entire community will be confined to their campus home. That community returns to Phase I. (See separate handout.) Remote learning will be utilized.

07

Recovery Home:

- Students who are positive for COVID-19 will be placed in the Recovery Home. They will remain there in their rooms per health expert guidelines.
- Symptomatic students are placed in a limbo room pending test results.
- A nurse will call the parent/guardian of the student each day to report on the student's health. Distance learning will take place contingent on symptoms and number of students in the home.
