Updated August 1, 2021

Grade school students will return to campus on Sunday, August 8, between 1 and 6 p.m. Students who do not return during that time can come to campus on Monday, August 9, between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. and follow a similar process.

High School students return August 15 between 1 and 5 p.m.

Enter campus through the main entrance.

At the four-way stop, smudge and receive masks. Masks are required for students and visitors on check-in day.

After this, follow signs to the front of the Dehon Health and Family Services Center. Family Service Counselors will welcome you and review consents.

Next, students complete a COVID-19 screening, a temperature check and health center check-in.

If your student presents with COVID-19 symptoms, they will transfer to a Recovery Home to await testing the next day. Alternatively, you can take your student home until cleared by a community clinic.

Once the Health Center visit is complete, students will go to their homes. You can help carry their belongings in and get them settled.

Stop by the Rec Center on your way off campus to pick up snacks and water for the road.
