ON CAMPUS



Students in grades 2 - 12 can stay on campus this summer. Grades 2 - 7 will take part in summer school and recreational activities.

Grades 8 - 12 can work on- or off-campus at least 30 hours per week. The program runs through July 5.

BOOKMOBILE



Through planning with Bird Cage Books and Mercantile in Rapid City, S.D., the Bookmobile makes its first-ever offering of Native American books by Native American authors. Some 1,800 individuals of all ages visit the Bookmobile as it traverses the state making stops in nearly 40 communities.

OUTREACH



Rec Center staff plan several outreaches to tribal youth programs throughout South Dakota. The Aktá Lakota Museum offers virtual experiences such as storytime with Uŋćí and Lala. School and Native Hope staff continue to meet needs for food and other items identified by families and communities.

More than 220 Native American students in 1st - 12th grades find opportunities to grow through our educational, counseling and residential programs. St. Joseph's Indian School transforms lives – mind, body, heart and spirit – every day.
